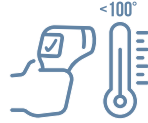
We're happy to welcome you back and excited to see you, serve you and aim to exceed your expectations once again.

TEMPERATURE CHECKS

All guests are required to have their temperature taken prior to check-in. Any guest with temperatures exceeding 100° F will not be permitted to remain on-site and will be given a full refund.



MANDATORY FACE COVERINGS

All individuals are required to wear a face covering if it is probable that another person will be encountered. If a guest does not have a face covering, a face mask will be provided.



FREQUENT CLEANING WITH HOSPITAL-GRADE PRODUCTS

From guest rooms, meeting rooms and food service areas to work spaces and high-touch surfaces like door handles, countertops, water faucets, shower handles, restroom doors, water-filling stations, to name a few, our team is sanitizing and sterilizing around-the-clock.



HOUSEKEEPING WILL NOT ENTER OCCUPIED ROOMS

Attendants will not enter your room at any time during your stay. Prior to your arrival, your room will be supplied with sufficient amenities. Additional pre-requested items such as linens, will be left outside your room. Rooms are safely and thoroughly sanitized and disinfected between guests.



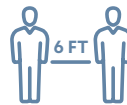
HAND SANITIZING MADE EASY

DAILY HEALTH SURVEY

All employees are required to complete this survey prior to coming to work. If an employee experiences any symptoms of illness they are to stay home.
